

ALBERT MARSH ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE SCHOLARSHIP

Amount of Award: Reimbursement of Expenses less than \$2000

Purpose: To cover student expenses from a variety of activities, including attending professional meeting, participating in workshops to enhance their research, meeting with collaborators to facilitate the start, continuation, or completion of a particular project. Priority will be given to those applications that show a strong educational and/or research component and show that the activity achieves the highest probability of the successful transfer of information pertaining to the student's research and/or educational objectives in environmental sciences.

Eligibility: Planning to present at any of the venues mentioned above. Students must have good standing as a graduate student whose advisor is a faculty member in the Department of Environmental Sciences.

Procedure: The following information must be provided for your application to be considered.

- Name and contact information (phone, email, and address)
- An unofficial transcript of your UCR academic record.
- Letter from student indicating expected benefits from activity.
- Letter of nomination and recommendation from research advisor.
- A letter addressed to the scholarship committee providing the following information:
 1. List the reason(s) you are applying for this award.
 2. List how this activity will facilitate your thesis/dissertation research or improve your knowledge base as an environmental scientist.
 3. A proposed budget.
 4. A timeline for the activity.
- Note: travel advances are possible
- Reimbursement amounts follow UCXR Campus Policy.
